

Junior Participation Program (JPP)

Autocross Event Requirements

Eligibility

- The JPP is available to 16- and 17-year-old sons or daughters of current PCA members in good standing.
- Only one JPP driver is permitted per event.

License Requirements

- The JPP driver must hold a valid, full-privilege driver's license. Learner's permits do not qualify.
- The JPP driver must present their license at registration.

Registration and Approval

- Prior approval from the Autocross Chair is required. Requests should be submitted a minimum of 1 week in advance of the event.
- First-time JPP drivers must attend pre-event instruction at 7:00 AM.

Required Forms and Waivers

The following forms must be presented at registration for every event:

- **Junior Participation Program Form** – Signed by both parents or legal guardians and signed by the JPP driver.
- **Minor Release Form (Waiver and Release of Liability and Indemnity Agreement for Minors)** – Signed by both parents or legal guardians and the JPP driver.

Forms must be presented to the Event Chairman, Autocross Chair, or Region President at registration the morning of the event.

Signature Requirements

- Both parents or legal guardians must sign the required forms witnessed by the Event Chairman, Autocross Chair, or Region President. The requirement for both signatures is waived only if one parent is deceased.
- In the case of divorced parents, both signatures are still required if both parents are living.
- If both parents cannot be present at the morning of the event for registration, a notarized waiver from the absent parent must be provided.

Since both parents must sign, we strongly recommend completing forms before arriving at the event.

Parental Responsibilities

- At least one parent or guardian must remain on premises and is responsible for the JPP driver at all times during their participation.
- A parent may not participate as a driver in the event unless a second parent or guardian is present to supervise the JPP driver.

Restricted Areas and Work Assignments

- JPP drivers may only enter restricted areas (course, start/finish, grid) when actively taking their runs.
- JPP drivers must remain in the designated area, at the timing table when not driving.
- JPP drivers are not permitted to volunteer or work in any restricted ("hot") areas.

Ride-Alongs and Instruction

Ride-alongs are permitted only with a designated autocross instructor. Instructors are designated by the Event Chair prior to the start of timed runs.

Conduct and Consequences

- Unsafe behavior, failure to follow rules, or conduct inconsistent with the spirit of the autocross program may result in immediate suspension of driving privileges.
- The Autocross Chair and Region officers reserve the right to refuse entry or suspend privileges at their discretion.
